PRE-PROCEDURE INFORMATION

Please refer to your physician's pre-procedure instructions, which will include your time of arrival, 45 minutes before your procedure time. If you have had any recent cold or flu-like symptoms, fever, or infections, have had any disease, such as MRSA, VRE, C-Diff, or TB, or have traveled out of the country within the last 30 days, please call **763.581.9082**. If you need to cancel or re-schedule your appointment, call your physician's office.

We present a Patient's Bill of Rights and Responsibilities with the expectation that observance of these rights will contribute to more effective patient care and greater satisfaction for the patient, their physician, and the North Memorial Ambulatory Surgery Center at Maple Grove. If you have an Advance Health Care Directive, please bring a copy with you at the time of your procedure or surgery.

BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

- You must arrange for someone to drive you home. You will need to have someone with you to receive your discharge instructions.
- · You must arrange to have a responsible adult stay with you for 12 hours following your procedure.
- Arrange childcare for the day of your procedure.

DAY OF PROCEDURE

- If recommended by your physician or your primary physician, oral medication may be taken with a sip of water.
- Consult with your primary physician regarding your insulin dosage for the day of the procedure and bring your insulin and diabetic supplies.
- Wear your hearing aid.
- If you wear contacts or glasses, bring your case and glasses.
- Leave jewelry and valuables at home, including all body piercings.
- Bring your ID and insurance card.





- Enter through outpatient center doors; entrance "B" between the hospital main entrance and urgent care.
- Check in at Suite 175 Front Desk on your left when you enter entrance "B".
- Your nurse and physician will evaluate you before your procedure. Please ask questions or communicate any concerns regarding the procedure.
- We request your caregiver remain at the center during your procedure.
- Please feel free to approach any staff member if you need assistance during your stay and share suggestions
 for our improvement. It is our goal that your experience with us is memorable and that in the future you will
 recommend our services.

YOUR RECOVERY

- After your procedure you will return to a patient room for observation and recovery.
- Discharge instructions will be given to you prior to your discharge. You will need to have a responsible adult available to hear your instructions.
- You may receive a courtesy call at home from the center to see how you are recovering. If you have any needs or concerns, please call your physician.
- When the procedure is over, the physician will speak with you and your caregiver(s), unless otherwise instructed.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

- If you have insurance, we will bill your insurance carrier. It is your responsibility to know your network coverage and benefits. If you have further questions, please contact your insurance carrier. Without this information, your claim will be delayed.
- It is the practice of North Memorial Ambulatory Surgery Center at Maple Grove to collect a portion of your estimated financial responsibility prior to your procedure. We calculate this amount based on our insurance contracted rates and your out-of-pocket responsibilities per your health plan. You will receive a call from our Insurance Verification Office to help you understand your responsibilities. If you do not have insurance or if you have difficulty meeting payment requirements, please contact our billing office at **763-581-9033**, as we are always available to discuss payment plans.
- In addition to receiving a statement from the surgery center, you may receive statements from your physician's office, pathology, durable medical equipment, radiology, etc., in the event services were provided related to your procedure.
- Your healthcare provider is referring you to a facility or service in which your healthcare provider has a financial or economic interest. You may request an owner list at any time at **763.581.9000** or **info@nmascmg.com**.

- You and your caregiver may use your cellular phone in our waiting room.
