















NMASC MG EMERGENCY CODES

Refer to Disaster Manual for policy details

CODE RED 	FIRE AND/OR SMOKE DETECTED R.A.C.E. / <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● RESCUE any persons in immediate danger ● ALERT by pulling nearest fire alarm pull system and dialing 9-9-1-1 ● CONTAIN the fire by closing doors to the area of the fire ● Extinguish (P.A.S.S.)/Evacuate and move beyond the fire doors P.A.S.S. / P-Pull pin, A-Aim at base of fire, S-Squeeze trigger, S-Sweep nozzle back/forth <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● UNIDENTIFIED ODOR: If odor is smoke/burning call 9-9-1-1 ● If another smell; investigate, call Building Mgt, or Security: 763-581-1105
CODE ORANGE	DISASTER ALERT/SHELTER IN PLACE An event has occurred creating a need for services above and beyond what is currently available. Notify Clinical Director and Department Managers Follow Emergency Action Plan All Hazard Approach
CODE YELLOW 	SECURITY THREAT (Bomb, Hostage, etc...) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● KEEP CALM - Threat via phone, do not get excited or excite others ● Call Police 9-9-1-1, Security at 763-581-1105 ● Call Executive Director or Manager to report security threat ● DO NOT TOUCH any suspicious item/package in your area ● Isolate the area of suspicious item/package
CODE GREEN 	HOSTILE SITUATION <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If a person or situation is causing a disturbance and/or putting people or property in danger, get help ● Notify Security at 763-581-1105 or call 9-9-1-1 if necessary
CODE BLUE 	ADULT/PEDIATRIC CARDIO PULMONARY RESPONSE /(CPR) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Call a NURSE MANAGER or NURSE for assistance and identify location ● Press call button in patients room ● ALL PERSONNEL should respond to assist for CODE BLUE ● Code Blue Pre-OP, Code Blue OR Code Blue PACU, Code Blue Post-OP ● Code Blue MH (Malignant Hyperthermia)
MISSING CHILD 	INFANT/CHILD ABDUCTION <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● IMMEDIATELY announce MISSING CHILD using EMERGENCY BROADCAST button on phones ● IMMEDIATELY REPORT a missing infant/child by calling 9-9-1-1 ● Notify Security by calling 763-581-1105
CODE SILVER 	ACTIVE THREAT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Recognize the threat ● Act: Run, Hide, Fight ● Report to Safety and Security X1-1105 or 9-1-1 ● Security will notify "All Clear"
SEVERE WEATHER ADVISORY 	SEVERE WEATHER ADVISORY (tornado, blizzard etc...) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● ALERTUS to notify of any severe weather ● Follow Severe Weather Advisory policy for Warnings ● Patients that can't be moved, should be turned away from windows, given blankets, and pillows for protection ● "All Clear" will be announced via Mgr/designated person
CODE HAZARDOUS SPILL TEAM 	HAZARDOUS SPILL OR LEAK In case of a chemical spill or leak; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Remove people to a safe area as needed (i.e. fumes overcoming) ● Secure the area

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call 9-9-1-1 and inform dispatcher of location and what has spilled if known • Call Security at 763-581-1105 • Notify a manager
MALIGNANT HYPERTHERMIA 	MALIGNANT HYPERTHERMIA <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call for help "CODE BLUE MH" and provide location • Obtain MH bin from anesthesia workroom • Obtain crash cart and follow procedure
SURGICAL FIRE 	SURGICAL FIRE (Components; Ignition Sources, Oxidizers, Fuels) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stop flow of breathing gases to patient (shut off medical gases) • Remove burning material from patient / extinguish burning material • R.A.C.E. / RESCUE, ALERT, CONTAIN, EXTINGUISH/EVACUATE • P.A.S.S. / PULL, AIM, SQUEEZE, SWEEP • If not controlled quickly, notify CODE RED, staff, and call 9-9-1-1
PANDEMIC FLU 	PANDEMIC FLU <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If Pre-Op determines a pt. has fever 100.4 and/or active symptoms, notify Anesthesiologist • Give patient / visitor a mask • Notify Clinical Director and follow procedure
CRITICAL UTILITIES 	LOSS OF CRITICAL UTILITIES <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call Maintenance Engineering at 763 581-2321 to report problems with or failures of the following utilities; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Air Conditioning • Electricity • Elevators • Heat • Medical Gases (oxygen, nitrogen, medical air) • Ventilation • Call Director or Administrative Services Cell: 612-655-5256 to report telephone failures • Call Vendor to report problems with office equipment
EMERGENCY BROADCAST 	EMERGENCY BROADCAST <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Push the Emergency Broadcast button on the phone • Enter 1111 • Speak clearly the Code/Emergency and location • Hang up
